# Tennis Team, non-homeowner Player Fee

The Ridge requires a Player Fee for non-residents playing on The Ridge ALTA, USTA and other teams. The non-resident pays this fee each time a team captain/sponsor submits their name on a Ridge team's roster. The current non-resident fees are as follows:

Adults: \$20 for each team/season played to a maximum of \$60/calendar year Juniors: \$15 for each team/season played to a maximum of \$45/calendar year

## Team's Responsibility:

• Each team will designate a team sponsor. The team sponsor must be a homeowner in The Ridge. The team sponsor may also serve as the team captain or co-captain.

## The Team Sponsor's Responsibility:

- Collect non-resident player fees from the players.
- Pay the non-resident player fees by check(s) (no cash) directly to the property management company.
   Checks will be made out to "The Ridge Club, Inc." Please mark on the check that the payment is for "non-resident tennis fees."
- Submit a roster of all players on the team, and annotate the roster to show which players are non-residents and which players are team captain and sponsor.
- Mail checks and roster, together, to:

- Pay all non-resident player fees prior to the team's first league match, regardless of whether or not the non-resident plays in that match. "Prior to" means the check must be postmarked prior to the day of the first league match. See paragraph below dealing with penalties.
- Pay non-resident player fees for any non-resident subsequently added to the team. The sponsor must submit an updated roster along with all required funds so that they are received prior to the added player's first match. The association will not refund or prorate non-resident player fees for players dropped from the roster initially submitted for the team.

### Community Management Associates responsibilities:

• Send the annotated roster, and summary of funds received from the team to the chairman of the Tennis Committee. This can be done via email.

### The Tennis Committee responsibilities:

Monitor the proper payment of non-resident player fees, and recommend penalties to the Board of
Directors for failure to make proper and timely payment of non-homeowner player fees. Penalty may
include revocation of the team's sanction and financial penalty against the team sponsor.

The team sponsor, team captain, non-resident player and the team members may be penalized for failure to make proper and timely payment of non-homeowner player fees. The Tennis Committee recommends penalties to the Board and the Board determines the final penalty.

Non-homeowner player fees will go to The Ridge operating budget for general use by the association.
